

St. Timothy's School, an Episcopal preparatory school in Raleigh, NC, with approximately 570 students in grades Pre-K to 8, anticipates one or more openings for a **Lower School Spanish Teacher** for the 2024-2025 academic year.

The Lower School Spanish Teacher position is intended to be a full-time, 10-month position, though part-time applicants will be considered. Duties begin in August 2024.

A St. Timothy's the Lower School Spanish Teacher will:

- Display a strong knowledge of developmental stages, differentiation and inquiry-based learning, and have familiarity with appropriate developmental educational programs.
- Create a supportive and caring classroom environment in which students can learn and interact positively with one another through student-centered instruction, discovery-based learning, collaboration, imaginative play, hands-on learning, and authentic skills-based assessment.
- Develop and implement age-appropriate Spanish language lessons and instruction.
- Bring innovation and creativity to the classroom.
- Be comfortable with integrating technology into the curriculum, collaborating with colleagues and working with children.
- Display excellent communication skills, both written and oral, with the ability to create and maintain accurate student records.
- Demonstrate high energy and commitment to professional development, staying current on research in education, independent schools and child development.

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

First and foremost, any St. Timothy's School employee must fully embrace every aspect of our <u>core values</u> shaped by our Episcopal School identity. Employees should also be committed to our <u>core commitments</u> and St. Timothy's School Mission Statement: *St. Timothy's Episcopal School is a nurturing community of academic excellence that instills the knowledge, skills, and values for a life of purpose.*

In addition, candidates should not only have excellent teaching and interpersonal skills, but also possess a deep understanding of developmentally-appropriate curriculum, a passion for working with young students, and a desire to collaborate with other educators. All candidates must also possess a bachelor's degree in an appropriate/relevant educational field.

The most competitive candidates will meet the following criteria:

- Possess a master's degree in an appropriate/relevant educational field
- Have at least 3-5 years of prior Spanish teaching experience in the grade level(s) for which he/she is being considered
- Have training in and/or successful prior ADI (Acquisition Driven Instruction) teaching experience using CI, TPRS, TPR.
