Qualifications:

Candidates should be flexible in their thinking, skilled communicators, comfortable navigating a community of diverse perspectives and opinions, and possess a good sense of humor.

A St. Timothy's Middle School Teacher will:

- Have an understanding of and love for working with middle-school students.
- Demonstrate best practice in their respective subject area.
- Challenge students, yet support the needs of learners within his/her class.
- Nurture the social and emotional needs of students.
- Create a supportive and caring classroom environment in which students can learn and interact positively with one another.
- Bring innovation and creativity to the classroom.
- Appropriately integrate technology into the curriculum.
- Collaborate with colleagues, particularly in the development of grade-level projects and cross-curricular opportunities as well as vertical curriculum adjustment and development.
- Communicate with parents and families about student growth, school events, and classroom activities.
- Demonstrate a commitment to professional development, staying current on research in education and on child development.
- Recognize and support the growth of students and colleagues.
- Participate in the development of school-wide goals and work towards their achievement.

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Hold a bachelor's degree in an appropriate/relevant educational field.
- Demonstrate excellent organizational and communication skills.
- Be able to work collegially with multiple constituencies.

The most competitive candidates will meet the following criteria:

- Possess a master's degree in an appropriate/relevant educational field.
- Have at least 3-5 years of prior teaching experience in the subject for which he/she is being considered.
